- **C.** Subject to all other terms and conditions of this policy, including this endorsement, we will pay for loss to the Covered Property scheduled in this endorsement, to the extent that the loss is not assumed by the Commodity Credit Corporation of the U.S. Department of Agriculture.

- **F.** Paragraph **a.** of General Condition **4.**, Mortgageholders, in the Farm Property Other Farm Provisions Form Additional Coverages, Conditions, Definitions, is replaced by the following:
 - The term mortgageholder does not include the Commodity Credit Corporation of the U.S. Department of Agriculture, nor any successor.
